The Applicant shall be mandatorily required to submit the Vigilance Clearance, Non-Objection Certificate and a statement showing details of major /minor penalties imposed on them, if any during the period of service, from the parent institute at the time of the interview if not already submitted with the application.

6. On completion of submission and scrutiny of the applications received, the shortlisted applicants will be called for an interview. Subsequent to the interview, verification of documents, and adherence to any other requirements prescribed by the Government, the Offer of Appointment will be issued to the selected candidate.
